



## Veteran Food Assistance



### Grocery Store Gift Cards/Certificates Available While Supplies Last

- ◆ Eligibility:  
Veterans/National Guard/Reserves/un-remarried surviving spouses  
Caregivers and service providers may apply on behalf of a Veteran they are assisting
- ◆ Applicants must live in the Upper Peninsula of Michigan.
- ◆ **Dial 2-1-1 (or 1-800-338-1119) Monday-Friday, 8:30am-4:30pm EST** to apply for the Veteran food card. Referrals to additional Veteran resources/services will be provided based on self-reported needs during the application process.
- ◆ **Proof of military service must be verified before food cards/certificates can be distributed** (ex. VA ID Card, DD-214, or other military/Veteran documentation).
