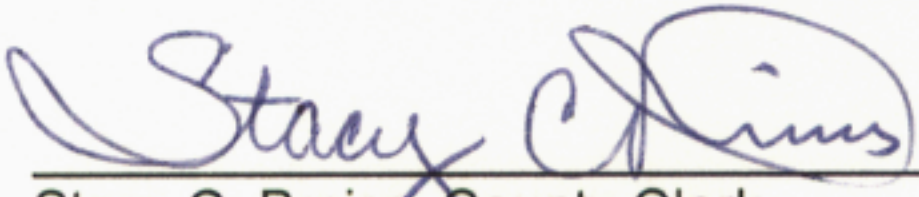

2023-10 RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT**

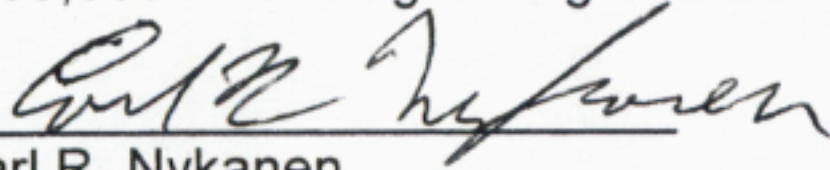

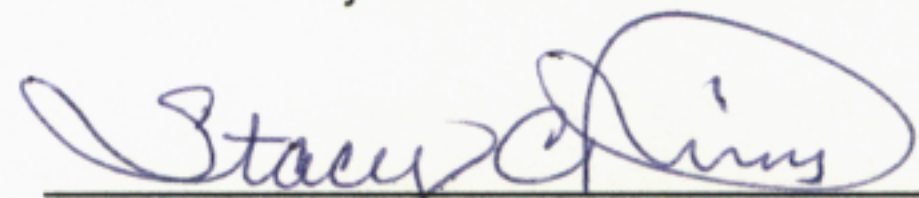
